The new FALLING | IN LOVE Grand Show opens at Berlin's Friedrichstadt-Palast on 21 September 2023. With a production budget of 14 million euros, it's the most expensive Grand Show to date. FALLING | IN LOVE is intoxicating beauty. An explosion of colour – curated by Parisian star designer Jean Paul GAULTIER. Berlin's new show jewel with the indescribable magic of 100 million Swarovski crystals. A new world record. The crowning glory of this crystal rush on the world's biggest theatre stage is the largest Swarovski crystal – in the world!

The word FALLING in the show title picks up on a feeling currently felt by many: the ground that we once thought to be so very firm beneath our feet seems to quake at times. At the Palast, we believe in the beauty of this world and in the good in people – despite everything. Hence our guests don't fall into a bottomless pit, but rather into a sea of colours – and love. The separating line in the show title reminds of this dual feeling: falling in the literal sense and the hope for a good outcome (falling in love).

The story

You is young, passionate and full of yearning. In Diamond City, he fails to fulfil any of the predefined notions and finds no love in the expressionless faces around him. Void of hope, You wishes only to sink into the ground. And indeed the asphalt does break under his feet – and You falls into another reality.

Down in the slumbering Garden of Love, he sees what he has never seen before: that the eternal human dream of a better world lives on. But, walled in by traditional norms, it has lost all its splendid colours.

Will a young, deaf poet ultimately find the words to make beauty and love blossom anew in all their splendour?

The new Grand Show is based on an idea by Berndt Schmidt and Oliver Hoppmann. Inspired by the poem 'The Garden of Love' by the English poet William Blake (1757–1827). Oliver Hoppmann, one of the most successful showmakers in Europe, is the show's author and director.

Producer & Director

Dr Berndt Schmidt is General Director and Producer of the spectacular new Grand Show. With FALLING | IN LOVE, Director and Author Oliver Hoppmann creates a finely tuned symbiosis of seductive joy for life and touching poetry.

Visual Design Director

Jean Paul GAULTIER adds his signature visionary style and touch to the show. For the Parisian star designer, returning to the Palast after THE ONE Grand Show in 2016 is like returning home, for he's a passionate revue fan.

Costume Design

As curator, Jean Paul GAULTIER also collaborates with up-and-coming fashion designers whose work he loves. These include the artists Hannah Rose and Steven Raj, who question gender boundaries and beauty ideals with their fashion under the name Fecal Matter. With over one million followers, they use social networks as a platform for their unique vision of beauty and reality. GAULTIER has also recruited the performance artist Sasha Frolova. With her striking aesthetic, the multidisciplinary artist not only designs spectacular inflatable latex costumes for the Grand Show, but also scenographic elements for the world's biggest theatre stage. The extraordinary cooperation with Swarovski allows the Palast's designers and creative team to draw on a wealth of resources. Hence 280 of GAULTIER's 550 costumes have been embellished with precision-cut crystals in a variety of sizes, colours and shapes.

Stage design

With a production budget of almost 14 million euros, this will not only be the most sparkling but also the most expensive Grand Show to date. As the stage architect and scenographer, Arthur Mamou-Mani and Yoko Seyama have worked together to create the stunning stage set for the new FALLING | IN LOVE Grand Show. 650 kilograms of crystals have also been incorporated into the stage set to create unprecedented magical effects. These include a crystal tree and sparkling branches in a Crystal Garden, a crystal pond and huge glittering flower elements. With a 9.5 m high waterfall and 25 m high rain wall, spectacular water elements also return to the Grand Show.

Ballet Ensemble

The international ballet ensemble under the direction of Alexandra Georgieva captivates with impressive choreographies by luminaries of the likes of Georges Momboye, Mark Smith, Sadeck Waff and 'The Greatest Showman' choreographer Ashley Wallen. The ballet company at the Palast comprising 60 members from 28 different nations is absolutely first-rate and unique the world over.
